Description of Major

The Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies (BSIS) is intended to allow students maximum flexibility to custom-design a curriculum to their personal and career goals. Students do this by choosing two or three "areas of emphasis" which must be selected from at least two colleges. The student must write a rationale for the program's direct relationship to the student's personal and career goal and be approved by a committee review.
