Description of Major

A Bachelor of Science in Biomedical Engineering is a growing interdisciplinary field of engineering that integrates engineering and life sciences to solve problems associated with the human body and human health. The curriculum is built on a core of fundamental math/physics/engineering courses which is similar across all engineering disciplines. It is distinguished by a wide range of life science courses and specialized biomedical engineering courses such as computational modeling, biomechanics, biomaterials, and bioinstrumentation.

The Biomedical Engineering program at Mississippi State University offers two concentration: Biomedical Engineering (no emphasis) and Biomedical Engineering (Pre-medical emphasis).
